ESTIMATED TRANSPORTATION AID TOOL

Enactment of SSA at 2.5% increased the FY 2025 standing appropriation for transportation aid by \$759,000 (2.5%) and totals \$31.1 million. HF 2612 TEACHER SALARY MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FAQ

The AEA bill (HF 2612) establishes increased teacher salary minimums effective **July 1, 2024**. The new **guidance document** provided by the lowa Department of Education addresses implementation questions organized by the calculation, use of funds, definition of experience, eligibility and BEDS data used.
