



High School Senior Scholarship & Student Teacher Grant Applicant Frequently Asked Questions

How are recipients selected?

All applicants who meet the eligibility criteria are entered into a random drawing. No additional scoring or ranking is used.

Why is a random drawing used?

The random selection process ensures fairness and equal opportunity for all eligible applicants.

How many Student Teacher Grants and High School Senior Scholarships are given?

The number of Grants and Scholarships is determined annually based on available one-time funding and board authorization.

If I am not selected, can I reapply?

No. Both the Student Teacher Grant and the High School Senior Scholarship are one-time opportunities. Applicants may apply once, as each award is intended to support a single, specific academic experience.

Is this a recurring program?

No. This program is supported by one-time funding and does not establish a recurring award commitment.

Can someone receive a Student Teacher Grant more than once?

No. Both the Student Teacher Grant and the High School Senior Scholarship are one-time awards. Individuals may not receive the same grant or scholarship more than once. This ensures broader access and fairness across applicants.

Is there a waitlist?

If an award is declined, alternates may be selected through the same random drawing process.
