**Board Books:** IASB updates the School Board Member Handbook each election year.

**New Board Member Portal:** Whether you've got a newly appointed or newly elected board member, check out the New Board Member Portal. **Pro tip:** Share the Glossary of Education Terms with your newbies.

**Open Meetings & Public Records:** All boards must adhere to Iowa's Open Meetings Law. **Pro tip:** Check out this [document](#) with information explaining the motions to enter into a closed session.

**Tentative Agreement Data:** IASB collects tentative agreements from districts during the negotiation season. **Pro tip:** This data is compiled into a district-by-district summary report.

**Salary and Benefits Data:** IASB offers downloadable spreadsheets to help you compare salary and benefits data for staff positions. These are based on the BEDS data reports. [Review FY 2024 data.](#)

**School Safety Resources:** This section includes school safety and mental health resources available to Iowa public schools, including Safe+Sound Iowa, Critical Incident Mapping, & Vulnerability Assessment.

**Superintendent Updates:** IASB tracks superintendent transitions each year. Check out where they've been, where they're going, and who's new.

**Online Policy Subscription Service:** The Policy Reference Manual is one of IASB's most popular services. The subscription-based service provides districts with online access to more than 430 sample policies. Additional resources included with the subscription include the Policy Primer Newsletter, a list of mandatory policies, and Title IX resources.
