Timely Tools & Resources

SUPPLEMENTAL STATE AID (SSA)/NEW MONEY CALCULATOR TOOL

While it is good to know how your district has fared financially in the past, it is equally as important to gain an understanding of where your district may be headed, financially speaking, into the future. Use IASB's <u>Supplemental State Aid (SSA) Calculator tool</u> to estimate the amount of "new money" (change in regular program funding from year to year) the district may receive over the next several years using assumptions you input on likely enrollment and SSA changes.

Together, with your board, you can use this information to answer the question: will we have sufficient additional resources in the future, or do we need to consider making strategic budget reductions now to stay financially healthy into the future?
