UTILIZE UPDATED SALARY & BENEFITS DATA TO INFORM DECISIONS FOR YOUR DISTRICT

IASB has released updated reports for FY 2023 <u>salary and benefits data</u> and <u>staffing level data</u> as reported in the 2022–23 Fall Basic Educational Data Collection (BEDS). The compensation data is available for 31 different positions and the five distinct staffing level data reports show the number of students based on served enrollment by school district, by FTE and position type.
