Celebrating 25 Years—The Lighthouse Study

IASB is celebrating **25 years of illuminating pathways to student success** with the <u>Lighthouse Study</u>. This impactful study revealed that school boards in high-achieving districts are significantly different in their knowledge and beliefs than school boards in low-achieving districts. This difference appears to carry through among administrators and teachers throughout these districts as well, according to results of a research study released in September 2000 by IASB.
