IASB Training Options—Open Meetings & Public Records Training

lowa law requires all newly elected or appointed school board, AEA, and community college board members to complete training on open meetings and public records. IASB offers a simple 90-minute session that is IPIB-approved, designed specifically for lowa board members, and includes a certificate of completion.

While only new members (newly appointed or elected after July 1, 2025) are required by law, IASB encourages all board members to participate annually to stay current, confident, and compliant.
