


Minority PK-12 Enrollments: 2014-15 to 2020-21

Enrollment data is collected annually each October from every school district by the Department of Education. Included in the data collection are grade levels, gender, and race/ethnicity. Additionally, the department collects this information at the school building level. See the <u>Department of Education's grade level enrollment data</u>.

The following table, chart, and maps provide information on public school minority enrollments in grades pre-kindergarten (PK) to grade 12 from the 2014-15 school year to the 2020-21 school year. During that time, minority enrollments have increased from 110,037 to 131,483 (an increase of 19.5%) and the percentage of minority enrollments has increased from 21.74% to 27.43%. Another item to note is the large reduction in enrollments for the 2020-21 school year due to the COVID-19 pandemic. While overall enrollments decreased by 7.4%, minority enrollments decreased by 0.5% for the 2020-21 school year. The following resources are available on the IASB website:
