

Minority PK-12 Enrollments: 2014-15 to 2019-20

Enrollment data is collected annually each October from every school district by the Department of Education. Included in the data collection are grade levels, gender, and race/ethnicity. Additionally, the department collects this information at the school building level. See the Department of Education's grade level enrollment data.

The following table, chart, and maps provide information on public school minority enrollments in grades pre-kindergarten (PK) to grade 12 from the 2014-15 school year to the 2019-20 school year. During that time, minority enrollments have increased from 110,037 to 132,083 (an increase of 20.0%) and the percentage of minority enrollments has increased from 21.74% to 25.53%.
