

Iowa High School Four-Year Graduation Rates by Subgroups

The lowa Department of Education collects and reports on the number of students that graduate from public schools each year, including a variety of subgroups of students. Because of timing issues in the data collections and methodology, graduation rates aren't determined until about a year after the graduations occur. The formula for calculating a four-year cohort graduation rate for the class of 2019 is as follows:

- (FG + TIG)/F + TI TO) where:
- FG = First-Time 9th grade students in the fall of 2015 and graduated in 2019 or before
- TIG = Students who transferred into the cohort in grades 9 to 12 and graduate in 2019 or before
- F = First-time 9th grade student in fall of 2015
- TI = Transferred into the first-time 9th graders' cohort in grades 9 to 12. TO = Transfer out (including deceased)

The following table and charts provide the four-year graduation rates by subgroup for the graduating classes from 2011 to 2019. All subgroups, with the exceptions of the White and Asian subgroups, are below the statewide average graduation rates for all the years shown. Statewide graduation rates for most of the subgroups has trended upward since 2010. Note that individual school district data is available on the Department of Education's website.
