- Has knowledge of school law and finance
- Has demonstrated leadership skills

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Qualities and Qualifications Surveyed

- Has built build consensus between individuals and groups
- Inspires trust, confidence, and optimism
- · Supports high quality teaching and learning
- Supports rigorous standards and high quality assessments
- Has established an effectively working relationship with a school board
- Has knowledge and experience in teacher training and staff development
- · Has demonstrated support for extracurricular activities
- Has facilitated new or renovated facility construction


The responses are displayed in the next several slides. Results are compared for district board members/staff and district parents/community members.

School Board and Staff Responses


The top 5 qualities/qualifications:
