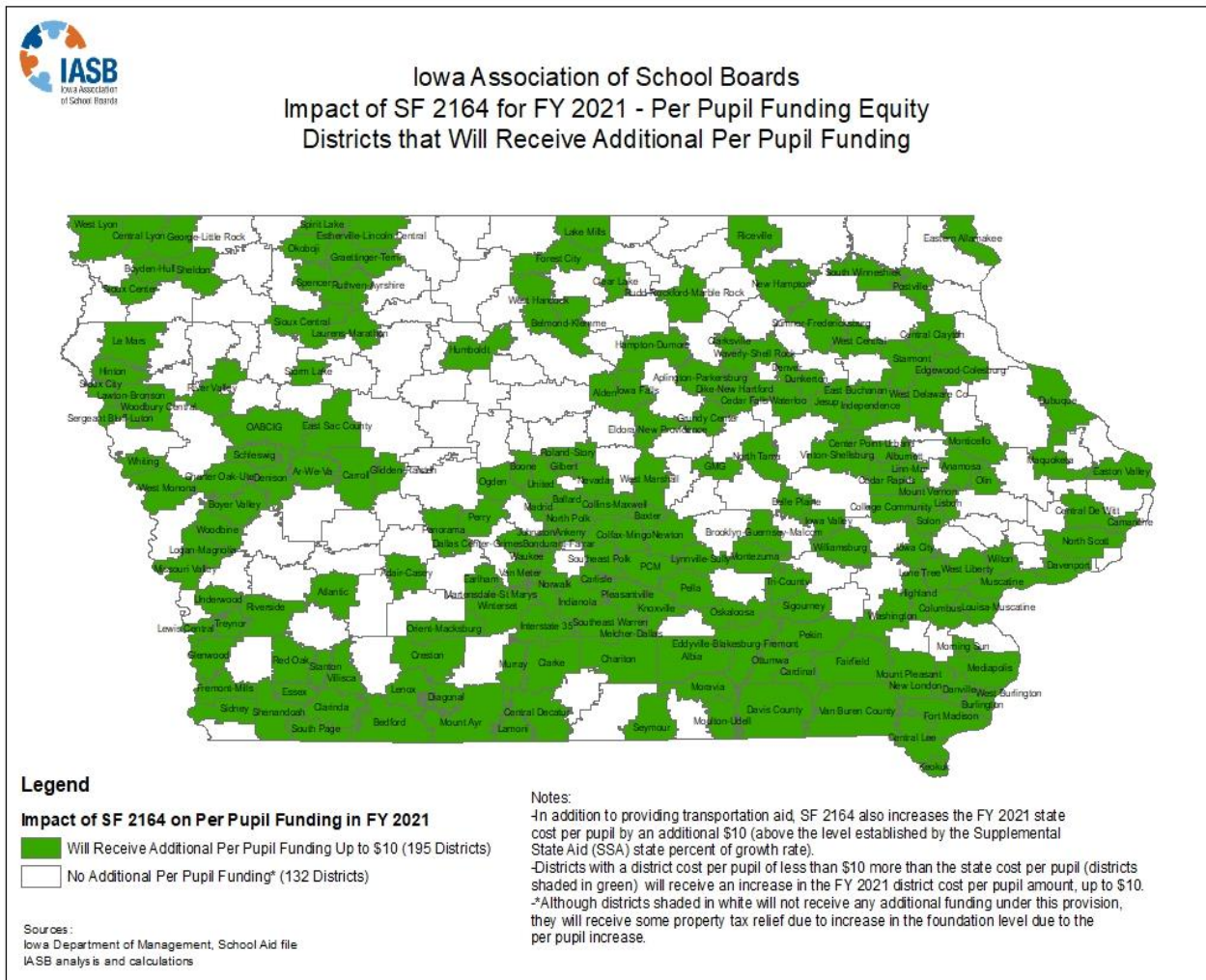


District Cost Per Pupil Equity Legislation (SF 2164)

The legislature passed and the Governor has signed SF 2164. This legislation provides an appropriation of \$27.7 million in transportation aid (topic of last week's Data Boost) and increases the FY 2021 state cost per pupil by an additional \$10 above the Supplemental State Aid state percent of growth rate level (not yet determined). The per pupil funding portion of the equity bill is designed to reduce the difference in the district cost per pupil amounts across the state. With enactment of SF 2164, the current per pupil difference between the minimum and maximum district cost per pupil amounts will be \$155. The following map identifies the districts that will receive up to an additional \$10 per pupil in FY 2021.

Districts that will not receive any additional per pupil funding under this provision will receive some property tax relief due to an increase in the foundation level due to the per pupil increase.
