

Students Per School District Square Mile

The Department of Education collects certified enrollment data and information pertaining to school transportation each fall. Included in the transportation data is each school district's square miles. This data boost uses the data for the 2018-19 to calculate each school district's student per square mile (based on the 2018-19 certified enrollments).

The following map provides information showing the students per school district square mile for the 2018-19 school year. The statewide average was 8.7 students per square mile while the state median was 4.13. Additionally, the range was from a low of 0.95 (West Harrison) to a maximum of 562.33 (Urbandale).
