



Data Dashboard – IASB Tools You Can Use

IASB has many data tools that provide you, your board and your district with specific data and the ability to compare your district's data with other districts.

The IASB has recently added and updated information impacting school finance issues in your district.

Advocacy Tools – Recently Updated

Supplemental State Aid Tools include:

[SSA and New Money Calculator](#)

[IASB Supplemental State Aid Impact Tool](#): This file provides the impact of the SSA on new money for all districts.

[State Categorical Supplement \(TSS, PDS, EIS, and TLS\) SSA Calculator](#): Provides estimates of each of the state categorical estimates for each district based on a self-selected SSA state percent of growth rate

District Cost Per Pupil Tools include:

[District Cost Per Pupil – FY 2021](#): This tool provides the estimated impact of equity legislation that increases the FY 2021 state cost per pupil. The user can select their district and enter an equity per pupil dollar amount to see the impact on their district.

[District Cost Per Pupil Comparison Tool](#): Provides an analysis of the differences in the district cost per pupil.

Transportation Tools include:

[Estimated FY 2021 Transportation Aid Allocation Amounts by District](#): This file provides an estimate of potential FY 2021 Transportation Aid Allocation amounts based on different appropriation amounts. Additionally, the file provides actual allocation amounts for FY 2019 and FY 2020.

Update to the Financial Focus Data Files

Financial Focus data files provide you an overview of your district's current financial status. Files that have been updated include:

[Enrollment Data](#): Funding follows the student so it is important to understand your district's enrollment numbers and what they mean for your district's financial health.

[SSA/New Money Calculator](#): This SSA/New Money Calculator provides information on regular program funding, the budget guarantee, new money, and the impact of future equity legislation. Additionally, this tool provides the ability to review 5-year projections of regular program funding.

[School District Finance Trend Information](#): This report provides trend information regarding budget enrollments, spending authority, annual generated spending authority versus expenditures, regular program funding, new money, and more.

School Finance Data – Historical and Trend Data

These files have been recently added:

NEW! [Enrollment and Staffing Level Trend Information](#): This file includes a summary of served and certified enrollments back to 2000-2001, staff FTE levels back to 2010-2011, and per pupil staffing levels back to 2010-2011 for each school district.

NEW! [Historic SAVE Allocation Amounts By District](#): This file provides the Secure an Advanced Vision for Education (SAVE) total and per pupil amounts for FY 2009 through FY 2019 and includes estimated projections for FY 2020.

[Certified Enrollment Comparison Tool](#): Provides current and historical data on certified enrollments including enrollment trend data for each of the variables included in the certified enrollment file. Additionally, this tool allows for comparison between districts on the various elements included in the certified enrollment.

Budget Planning and Monitoring Tools

[Special Education Balance Calculator](#): How can your district project what next year's special education balance might be?

[Commercial and Industrial Rollback Property Tax Backfill Tool](#): This tool allows you to see the history of the commercial and industrial rollback property tax backfill allocation amounts for each school district. Additionally, the tool provides the estimated impact this provision has had on a school district's total property tax rate for the most current year.

[FY 2021 Property Tax Levy Impact Calculator](#): This tool allows the user to calculate the estimated impact of the total school tax levy on residential, commercial, and agricultural properties within each school district.
