

Make the Most of the IASB Website

The IASB website is the go-to resource for board/superintendent teams to access resources, tools and tips to excel in their governance and leadership roles. In order to make the most of the IASB website, we encourage you to follow these three simple steps:

Step 1: Ensure You Are Set Up to Access Members-Only Content

The first step to exploring the website is to ensure you are set up to access members-only content. While some content on the site is available to the public, much is designed just for our members.

Login Instructions

1. Go to www.ia-sb.org. Click on MY IASB LOGIN, at the top or bottom of the website. This will take you to a member login page.
2. Enter your USERNAME. This is your email address on file with IASB. If we don't have your email address, just let us know. Then enter your PASSWORD and hit SIGN IN.
3. For first-time users, click on Forgot My Password. A link to reset your password will be emailed to you and you may set your own password.

Financial Tools: Get a clear picture of your district's financial health with IASB's Financial Focus Tools. Find district-specific data on key financial indicators, compare your district to other districts and trends, access budget planning resources, and better understand Iowa's school funding formula.

Policy & Legal Corner: Stay current with emerging laws and issues and get your most frequently confronted policy and legal questions answered quickly.

HR Central: School employees are an essential asset to any district. These tools help board members understand their role and provide school administrators with resources on management issues.
